

Question: *Is your faith dead, or is it alive?*

Saving faith is shown in action (14-17)

The point is not to get us to measure the faith of others

The point is to consider the authenticity of our own faith

Saving faith and action are inseparable (18-19)

Workless words are worthless

Saving faith is never alone

Ephesians 2:8-10 (NIV)

⁸ For it is by grace you have been saved, through faith—and this not from yourselves, it is the gift of God— ⁹ not by works, so that no one can boast.

¹⁰ For we are God's workmanship, created in Christ Jesus to do good works, which God prepared in advance for us to do.

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Application:
