**1. The first invitation of Jesus was to come and investigate!
(John 1:35-42)**

- a. Jesus did not fear investigation
- b. Some were repelled by his claim of Lordship
- c. Those who investigated Jesus were drawn to him

**2. The second call of Jesus was to come and imitate!
(Mark 1:14-20)**

- a. Following Jesus means leaving some things behind
- b. Following Jesus means accepting new responsibilities

3. There is wisdom in following Christ. (Prov. 8 and John 10:10)

- a. Jesus is the author and sustainer of life
- b. Jesus is the smartest man to ever live
