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“Suit up for Battle” *Ephesians 6:10-24 (NIV)*

1. The spiritual world is real (11, 12)

- a. Our battle is against the powers of this dark world
- b. They are scheming for our destruction

2. Be strong in the Lord (10-12)

- a. We use God’s resources for strength and protection

3. Put on the armor of God (13-20)

- a. We know the truth (belt)
- b. We are righteous (breastplate)
- c. We are ready with the gospel (fitted feet)
- d. We are shielded by our faith in the Lord Jesus (shield)
- e. Our salvation is settled (helmet)
- f. The word is our weapon (sword)
