The Final Plague

- Egypt suffered while the nation of Israel had been spared the discomfort, destruction, and dread of the nine plagues. The final plague would assure Israel’s release from Egyptian slavery.
- The final plague took the life of Egypt’s first born of that generation. The judgment of Egypt and its gods was complete.
