- 1. We expect to receive God's promise of blessing (1-7)
 - a. God was faithful to provide for Abraham's family (1-5)
 - b. God was faithful to multiply Abraham's family (6, 7)
- 2. Sometimes we don't <u>experience</u> the blessing of God (1:8-2:11)
 - a. Israel encountered a <u>fearful</u> Pharaoh (8-10)
 - b. Israel was oppressed through hard work (11-14)
 - c. Israel is threatened with genocide (15-22)
 - 1. The Hebrew midwives feared <u>God</u> more than Pharaoh (17-21)
 - 2. Moses' mother lets him <u>live</u> and lets him <u>go</u> (2:1-4)
 - 3. Pharaoh's daughter doesn't <u>follow</u> in her father's footsteps (5-10)
 - 4. Miriam saw an opportunity and seized it (4, 7-9)
