## “Whole-Hearted Obedience” Exodus 4

1. **Moses questions the reaction of others (1-9)**
  - a. God demonstrated power over the serpent
  - b. God demonstrates power to inflict harm or to heal
  - c. God promises a demonstration of power over their source security
2. **Moses again questions his own ability (10-12)**
  - a. God graciously reminds Moses of his assistance
3. **Moses confesses his own lack of desire (13-17)**
4. **God confronts Moses’ own integrity (18-31)**
  - a. Moses had not obeyed the Lord completely
  - b. Ministry and leadership start with obedience at home
